The House met one hour thirteen minutes behind stipulated sitting schedule

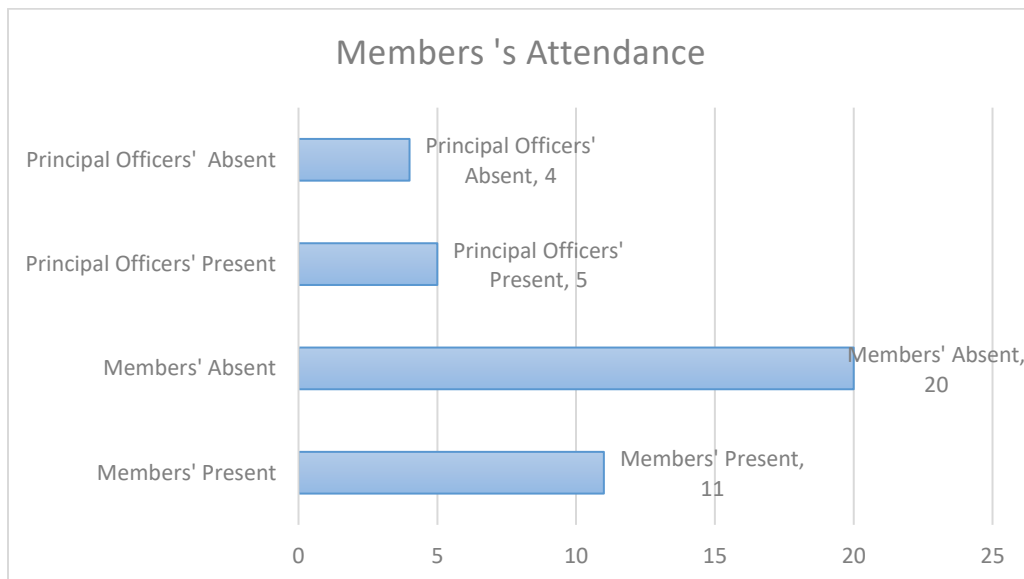

### ANALYSIS:

**Five Principal Officers attended the day's sitting and Nineteen Members which constituted two-third of the House Membership.**



The total number of the Honorable Members present during the day's sitting are 24. Five (5) Principal Officers attended the sitting, Four (4) were absents. However, Eleven (11) Floor Members were present while 21 where absents.

### **3. CONFIRMATION OF APPOINTMENT**

The Hon. House confirmed the appointment of Dr. Muhammad Nazifi Bichi as Commissioner/ Member of the State Executive Council after deliberation by the Honorable Members at the committee of the Whole House.

#### ***Analysis***

The State Government relieved Dr. Muhammad Tahar Adam aka Baba Impossible of his appointment and the House of Assembly confirmed the appointment of Dr. Muhammad Nazifi Bichi Bichi as a Commisioner and Member of the State Executive Council.

Dr Muhammad Nazifi Bichi Bichi is a Lecturer in Arabic Department Bayero, University, Kano and has interest in Arabic Literature and Criticism

### **4. KANO STATE PENSION AND GRATUITY (AMENDMENT) LAW, 2022 (1444 A.H)**

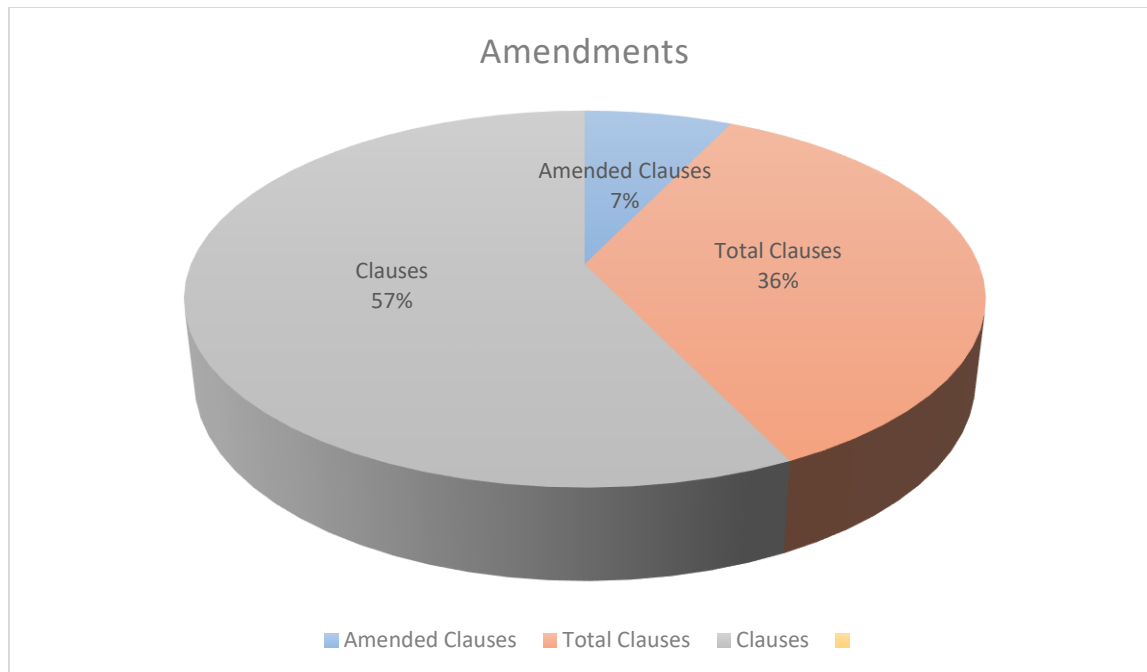
Motion Made and question proposed that, the House do now consider the Kano State Pension and Graituty (Amendment) Law, 2022 (1444. A.H) sponsored by **Hon.Labaran Abdul Madari; Majority Leader** (*Warawa*)

Seconded by **Hon. Nuhu Abdullahi Achika (Wudil)**

## Analysis

- The Clauses amended from the Principal law are as follows

## ANALYSIS

- The Motion was sponsored by the by the Majority Leader Hon. Labaran Abdul Madari following a Motion of Urgent Public Importance.
- Five Clauses from the Principal Law have been Amended
- The review of Kano Pension is geared towards assuaging the problems and sufferings of pensioners and families of dead Civil Servants who are obliged to claim their entitlements
- The amended Law would pave way for extension of retirement age for civil Servants from 60 to 65 years, while year of service would be reviewed from 35 years to 40 years

## **5. ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) LAW, 1949**

**Hon. Aminu Sa'adu Ungogo** (Ungogo) emphasized the importance of the road construction to the residents of these areas from the economic social and security point of view.

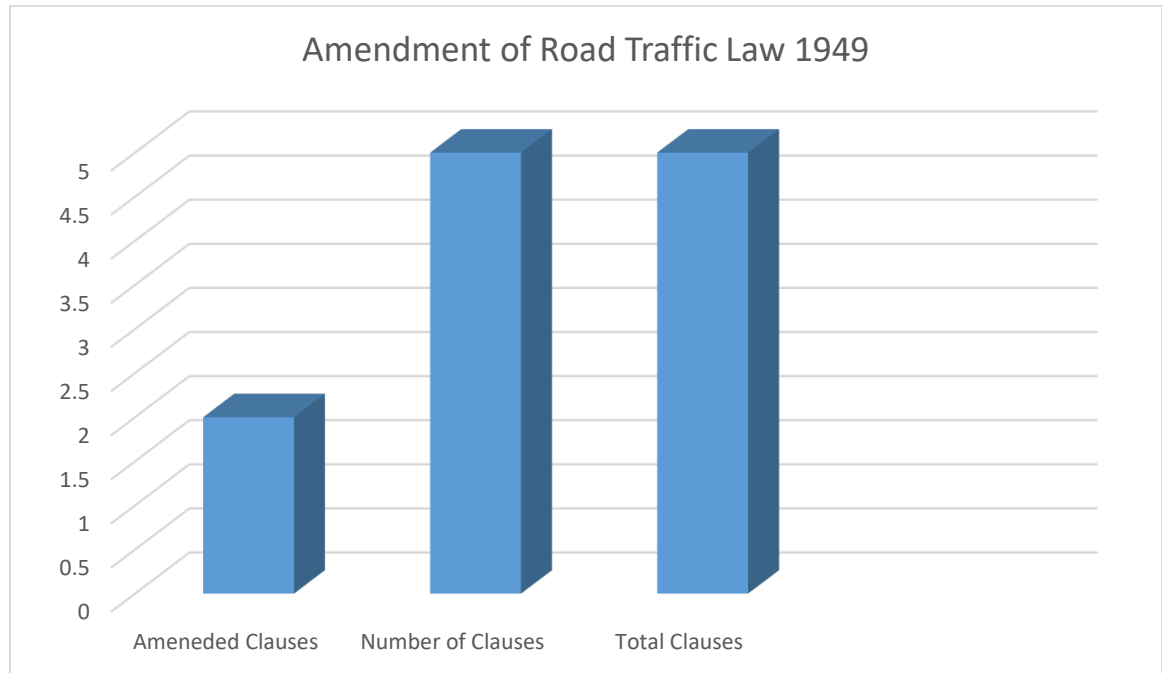

- The Bill was **Sponsored by Hon. Labaran Abdul Madari Majority Leader (Warawa)**
- **The Bill contained five Clauses out of which 3 and 4 have been amended.**

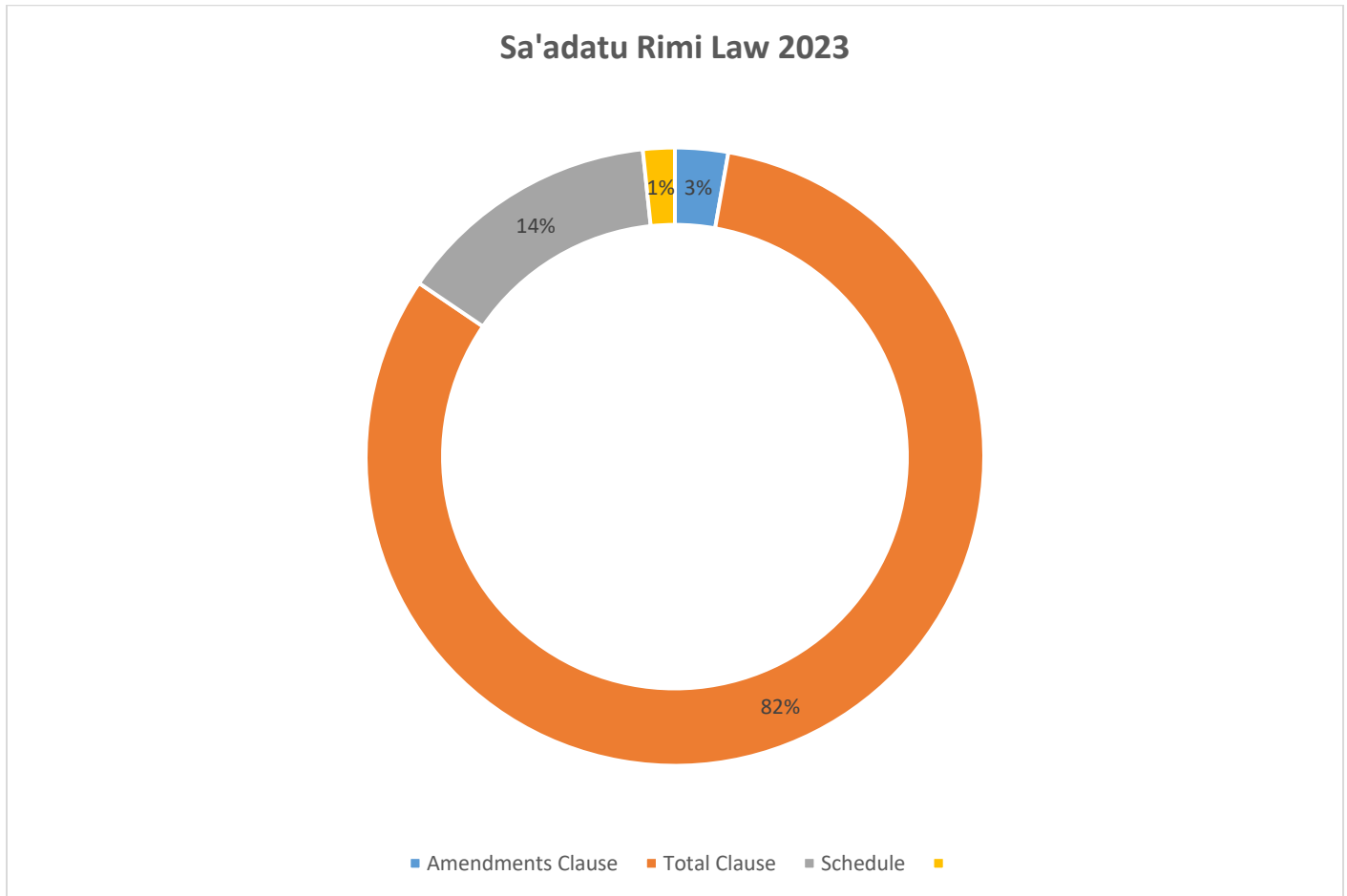
### **ANALYSIS**

- The Bill contained 59 Clauses and 10 Schedule.
- Provide facilities for teaching, learning, research and community services in such branches of knowledge especially the broad area of education with emphasis on degrees and higher degrees in education
- Serve as a means of producing graduate professional teachers with pedagogical, technical and entrepreneurial skills in all field of human endeavors to cater for the manpower needs of the public and private sectors
- Collaborate with other institutions of higher learning, both locally and abroad for the exchange of staff, ideas and curriculum
- Provide the type of higher education that is morally oriented and responsive to the cultural heritage and needs of the society
- Dedicate itself to the challenges of solving societal problems by encouraging collaboration and innovative multidisciplinary research
